Here are some guidelines for each stage of your baby's development

6 months

does your baby...

- Reach for toys and pick them up?
- Move toys from one hand to the other?
- Roll over (both ways)?
- Play with feet?
- Babble?
- Help hold bottle while feeding?

12 months

does your baby...

- Pull self to a standing position?
- Crawl on hands and knees?
- Drink from a cup?
- Wave "bye-bye"?
- Play peek-a-boo and patty cake?
- Say 1 or 2 words?

18 months

does your baby...

- Pull off his/her shoes?
- Feed self a cookie?
- Walk without help?
- Use 8-10 words that are understood?
- Turn pages in a book?

24 months

does your baby...

- Run?
- Say 2-3 word phrases?
- Say names of toys?
- Point to eyes and nose?
- Play alone?
- Stack blocks?
- Take clothes off?

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
